Neighbourhood Panel:

- Presently we have the Neighbourhood Support Coalition (NSC) city provides HR Resources
- > Presently city allocates money (approximately \$50,000) for all the neighbourhood groups
- > All neighbourhood are different. The \$\$\$ allocation is divided up by NSC at an allocation meeting
- At present the city supports us financially but we all have to fight for funding
- New system will be a third party that will take over the support systems
- > The new neighbourhood panel terms of reference is being developed
- > There are many different partners.
- ➤ Each Neighbourhood group will be required to have a general framework established as to the design of the neighbourhood group if we want to get money. The makeup of each group may be different depending upon the need.
- We need to have an Elected board, bylaws, Action plan and rules of order.
- > To obtain funding one person identified by the NG must attend meetings of the neighbourhood panel
- ➤ Dean will send the proposed terms of reference for neighbourhood panel for us to review and make comments and send back to Dean so that our comments can compiled and resent before Jan 19th
- ➤ Everyone now working for neighbourhood groups will be laid off and will be rehired under the new neighbourhood panels. There was some discussion about how this might occur. We do not know what the final process will be so we agreed to defer any comments or action until after the process had been worked out by the Neighbourhood panel. However it was made very clear that we had no desire to go through a hiring process again!
