# **Presentation of Time Bank**

- Justine Dainard gave a brief demonstration of Time Bank and what it is
- What is a Time Bank?
- It's a group of people using a system of volunteering that exchanges skills
- It's a way of building community
- It's an alternative monetary system that uses time instead of dollars
- Within a Time Bank, for every hour that you volunteer to meet the needs of another member, you earn a time credit for the exchange.
- This time credit can then be redeemed for services from any other member of the Time Bank
- Every person has something to share, skills, knowledge, talent, strength, or companionship
- This is of value to another, and everyone's time is valued equally
- Time shared could include, baby-sitting, gardening, snow-shovelling, bike maintenance, homework help and so on...
- No cost to join
