**Financials:**

- we have approximately \$35,000
- have not been billed for staffing by the City of Guelph
- Jenn working on 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter financials to hand into the city of Guelph

**Boonanza:**

- Sunday Oct 28<sup>th</sup>, 2012
- 1-4 pm is event times
- 10am set up time
- KHNG has sold 64 pumpkins for pumpkin fundraiser
- Mosborough Country Market will provide pumpkins at \$2 each and KHNG sell pumpkins for \$3.50
- Leone to pick up first pumpkins for Kortright Hills Public School Sunday Oct 21<sup>st</sup> as they need Monday Oct 22<sup>nd</sup>
- Leone to pick up rest of pumpkins Friday morning
- Neighbourhood to pick up pumpkins Friday evening 6:30 to 8:30 and Saturday morning 10am to 12 noon
- Community has been notified to bring carved pumpkin for contest – 3 categories (scariest, silliest and most creative)
- Event list: Scouting Table, KHNG Outreach Table, Carved Pumpkin Contest, Colouring and Craft Station, Photo Booth, Colouring Contest Station, Spin the Wheel Game, Pin the Face on the Pumpkin Game, Toss the Bean Bag in the Witches Mouth Game, Ghost Bowling Game, Face Painting Station, Trick or Treater, Haunted House
- Andrew the absolute Normal will attend between 1 and 2pm for about 45 min to an hour
- Will have door prizes (2 - \$20 Fat Duck certificates and Play with Clay)
- KHNG Outreach Table – Leone to work with volunteer – will promote Movie in the Gym Night December 14<sup>th</sup> (get community to vote on movie – Elf, Santa Claus or The Grinch), will get significant stories from community, each significant story community member can fill out a ballot for door prize and display photos of past events
- Two extra games have been added at outreach table – guess the number of jelly beans in the jar and also guess the weight of the pumpkin
- Used Sign up Genius to get volunteers for Boonanza... this has been a great tool and we have lots of volunteers for our event, will use for future events
- Jen to get two floats (concession stand and photo booth) and boxes

- Linda Main has agreed to donate \$100 to boonanza, this money will be used to purchase 3 prizes for carved pumpkin station, 3 prizes for colouring contest station and treats
- Need to secure a sound system (getting from the school) and music for the day
- Leone to purchase prizes, treats, drinks for concession stand
- Pick up a little bit more decorations
- Leone to email Doug to see if he needs any supplies for Photo Booth
- Leone to contact Fire Department – re use of fog machine in the Haunted House
- Jenn to get music for Boonanza
- School has sound system that we can use

### **KASP:**

- Leone and Jessica are still looking for Volunteers to assist with the Fall program
- Jessica has requested using 1<sup>st</sup> Light Theatre for Winter Session that is to begin January to end of March - \$90 per child for 9 weeks
- Jen is to put together a forecast for KASP for new session to see if 1<sup>st</sup> Light Theatre would be possible for program
- Jessica has other resources that she would like to use, has small cost waiting to hear what Jen puts together as a forecast for KASP before a decision is made
- Registration for the Winter KASP program will begin early December
- Registration for Winter KASP program will be offered to current KASP families as well as those on waiting list
- KASP registration will be a first come first basis, as this gives all a chance for the new session
