Boonanza:

- Need to network earlier re pre ordering for pumpkins
- Need to ask school if we can send out information regarding ordering pumpkins and brining in Carved pumpkins for carved pumpkin contest
- Will have 3 categories again this year for carved pumpkin contest (most creative, silliest, scariest) – need 2 volunteers
- 26th Guelph Venture Scouts to do Haunted House again this year – Alex Post
- Venture Scouts have asked to promote their event separate, will do separate flyer and advertise on own – Alex Post to follow up and work on
- Will look for volunteers to do face painting – need 3 or 4 volunteers
- Have face painting materials left over from last year, check supplies to see if we have enough
- Photo Booth will be done again – Doug has agreed to do booth – Doug to arrange
- Doug has requested assistance with set up and sign up for photos
- \$1 per photo again this year
- Colouring station and craft station again this year – need at least 4 volunteers
- Colouring contest – 3 categories as last year (up to 4 year, 5 to 7 years and 8+ years) – need 2 volunteers – Leone to provide 4 different colouring sheets for children to use
- Will have about 4 games for the children to play (spin the wheel, ghost bowling, witch bean bag toss, pin the face on the pumpkin) – Leone and Jessica to look after
- Will need treat bags for each of games (4) and one for the redeem treat coupon person
- Need a co-ordinator for the day of event to make sure everything is done when it should be – Jennifer has agreed to be this person
- Need to secure a sound system and music for the day
- Linda Main has been approached for a donation to purchase prizes for contests and treat handouts – Leone to follow up
- Will do the treat hand out again this year as well – 1 volunteer needed
- Need Greeter/Counter – 2 volunteer needed

- Need to do inventory of supplies for Boonanza event – Leone to do
- Connect with police to see if they could talk with the kids – Jennifer to connect
- Concession stand will consist of Pop, Juice, Water, Popcorn, small chocolate bars and freezies – Jen to pick up small chocolate bars
- Scouting Table – Leone to ask Paul if he would like a table
- Out Reach Table – to show photo board from other events and collect stories from community
- Have gift certificates left over – Fat Duck for door prizes – need to decide if we are going to use and how many
