Downey Rd. Development

 Adrian and Wendy came to the meeting to discuss a development that is proposed for Downy Rd. and inform the group of the development and concerns that individuals have about it.

- Concerns include: Increased traffic especially implications for the centre left turn lanes, overflow parking, tree removal (approx ³/₄ of existing tree canopy), architectural consistency as development expected to be 5 stories high (4 if you do not include the bottom/ garage floor), schools in the area are at capacity
- To note: intensification corridors do not include this location density requirements could be met with a more desirable development in this area.
- 8 people from the neighbourhood are presenting a petition with 250 names on it to City Council
- The developer is Seaton Ridge to see plan, info, zoning comments etc. about the development check the City Council meeting minutes on the City of Guelph Website using the City Council links.
- Want to know if the group is interested in being involved in advocacy regarding this development (or other developments)
- Presently the Neighbourhood Group is positioned to build community with event/recreational objectives but as they are a neighbourhood group they are open to responding to the needs of the community as they come forward.
